King County Library System • Get Your Library Card

The Library Card Application form is available in English, Arabic, Chinese, French, Korean, Russian, Somali, Spanish, and Vietnamese.

1 At a KCLS Library, ask for a Library Card Application form in your language or download a PDF online: www.kcls.org/usingthelibrary/card

2 Fill out the form.

3 Bring your completed form to your local KCLS library with:

Photo identification with birth date (one piece required for adults).

Acceptable examples are as follows and may be current or expired:

- Driver's License
- Passport
- Washington ID Card
- U.S. Military ID
- Matricula Consular (issued by Mexican government)

AND Address verification matching qualifying residential address and given name (one piece required for adults and minors).

Acceptable examples—chosen document must be current:

- Washington Driver's License
- Washington ID Card
- Printed Checks
- Utility Bill (printout of online bill acceptable)
- Apartment Lease
- Voter's Registration
- King County Tax Bill
- Other (Must be of a legal or permanent nature)

If residence address differs from mailing address, the residence address determines patron eligibility.

You may get a library card today without address verification, but you will be limited to checking out 2 items. If you do not bring address verification, the card will expire after 90 days.

4 Receive your library card!

Please note, you are responsible for all materials borrowed with your card.

If your card is lost or stolen, report it to your local library.

Ask staff if you have questions about getting a library card or using the library.

Staff can also assist with the **Language Line** service to contact an over the phone interpreter.
